We will be taking the following precautions while continuing to operate, until further notice.

- Frequent hand washing and hygiene practices will be encouraged. Where hand washing is not available, hand sanitizer will be readily available in our company vehicles
- Whenever possible our staff will adhere to social distancing recommendations
